



Report on Voting Results of Nortel Networks Corporation

In accordance with Section 11.3 of National Instrument 51-102 – *Continuous Disclosure Obligations*, we hereby advise of the results of the voting on the matters submitted to the annual and special meeting (the “Meeting”) of shareholders of Nortel Networks Corporation (the “Corporation”) held on May 2, 2007 in Nepean, Ontario.
